On September 30, 2020, the City received four bids for the Asotin Street and Railroad Avenue Stormwater System Improvements project. The bids ranged from \$523,712.92 to \$618,509.26. The Engineer's Estimate was \$561,758.61. Each proposal was checked for correctness of extensions of the prices per unit and the total price. Eighteen corrections were made; however, these corrections did not change the position of the low bidder. We have provided a bid summary with this letter. The bidders and their respective bid amounts, including sales tax where applicable, are as follows:

The City is advised that the bid proposal submitted by Burly Products d.b.a. JR Construction included an amount for the TERO fee of \$0.00. Burly Products d.b.a. JR Construction provided additional documentation (attached) from the Tribal Employment Rights Office certifying that Burly Products has met all requirements to be recognized as a Certified Title 10 Company for the calendar year 2020 and is entitled to all rights of a preferred entity in good standing as determined by Title 10 Code and the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation. The lowest responsive bidder, Burly Products d.b.a. JR Construction of Post Falls, Idaho, is currently a Washington State registered and licensed contractor and appears to have the relevant qualifications and experience to successfully perform the work the project will require. To our knowledge, the lowest bidder has not claimed bid error and no formal bidding protests have been recorded. In accordance with RCW 39.04, we have verified the lowest bidder, Burly Products d.b.a. JR Construction of Post Falls, Idaho, has met the responsibility criteria. The Mandatory Bidder Responsibility Checklist, including documentation, is attached for the City's file. We have also reviewed the Supplemental Bidder Criteria information submitted by Burly Products d.b.a. JR Construction and they appear to meet the requirements of the Supplemental Bidder Responsibility Criteria.
