Ordinance 1897 Amending Budget - Garbage Fund

The Attached <u>Ordinance 1897- Amending the 2020 Budget for the City of Omak, Appropriating Additional Expenditures in the Garbage Fund,</u> is forwarded for your consideration.

We have had an increased demand for garbage services. As a result of the extra demand, the cost for contracted services and B&O tax costs have increases. The Ordinance appropriates an additional \$30k for these costs.

I did not capture the additional revenues in this ordinance, but I estimate revenues will exceed my 2020 estimates by \$70k.

ORDINANCE NO. 1897

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2020 BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF OMAK APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURES IN THE GARBAGE FUND

WHEREAS, the City of Omak adopted the 2020 Budget by passage of Ordinance No. 1885 on December 2, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the contract with Sunrise Disposal for garbage collection and disposal, is based on per unit pricing; and

WHEREAS, the service volume for garbage is exceeding 2020 estimates; and

WHEREAS, an additional appropriation is needed to support the additional costs for the contracting and administration of the higher volume of garbage services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Omak is desirous of amending its budget pursuant to RCW 35A.33.090.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAK DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 1885 adopting the 2020 Budget, shall be amended to include changes to the budget as shown in Attachment "A" of this ordinance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its passage by Council by a vote of one more than the majority of all Councilmembers, approval by the Mayor and publication as required by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 1898

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF OMAK, WASHINGTON, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the CITY OF OMAK, Washington completed and placed on file with the City Clerk, a proposed budget and estimate of the amount of the moneys required to meet the public expenses, bond retirement and interest, reserve funds and expenses of government of said CITY for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2021, and notices were published that the Council of the said CITY would meet on the 16th day of November, 2020, at the hour of 7:00 P.M. for the final 2021 Budget Public Hearing in the Council Chambers at the City Hall of said CITY, for the purpose of making a budget for said fiscal year and giving taxpayers within the limits of Omak an opportunity to be heard upon said budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council did meet at said time and place and did then consider the matter of said proposed budget; and

WHEREAS, the said proposed budget does not exceed the lawful limit of taxation allowed by law to be levied on the property within the CITY OF OMAK for the purposes set forth in said budget; and

WHEREAS, the estimated expenditures set forth in said budget being all necessary to carry on the government of said CITY for said year and being sufficient to meet the various needs of said CITY during said period.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the CITY OF OMAK do ordain as follows:

- <u>Section 1.</u> The budget for the CITY OF OMAK, Washington for the Year 2021 is hereby adopted at the fund level in its final form and content as set forth in the document entitled <u>City of Omak Final 2021 Budget</u>, copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
- <u>Section 2</u>. Estimated resources for each separate fund for the City of Omak, and aggregate expenditures for all such funds for the year 2021 are set forth in summary form, as shown in "Exhibit A", and are hereby appropriated for expenditure at the fund level during the Year 2021 as set forth in the <u>City of Omak Final 2021 Budget</u>.
- <u>Section 3.</u> The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of the budget hereby adopted to the Division of Municipal Corporations in the Office of the State Auditor and to the Association of Washington Cities.
- <u>Section 4.</u> The ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days after its publication according to law.
