NEWSLETTER

The Omak Volunteer Fire Department held their annual banquet February 16th. During the banquet, Fire Chief Bowling reported 2018 statistics for the department. He shared that there were 294 calls for service. 156 calls inside the city and 138 calls in other fire districts and cities. The calls include 70 fires, 80 rescue & emergency medical incidents, 6 hazardous conditions with no fire, 9 service calls, 1 rupture/explosion calls, 69 good intent calls and 59 false calls. The dollar loss inside the City was \$463,150 and outside the City was \$478,650. The volunteers spent 1,833 man hours on fire calls and 2,354 man hours training. The City provided mutual aid to: City of Okanogan 6 times, Fire District No. 7, 11 times, Fire District No. 6, 1 time, Fire District No. 8, 2 time and Fire District No. 9, 4 times.

In keeping with tradition, several firefighters were recognized for the number of calls they responded to in 2018.

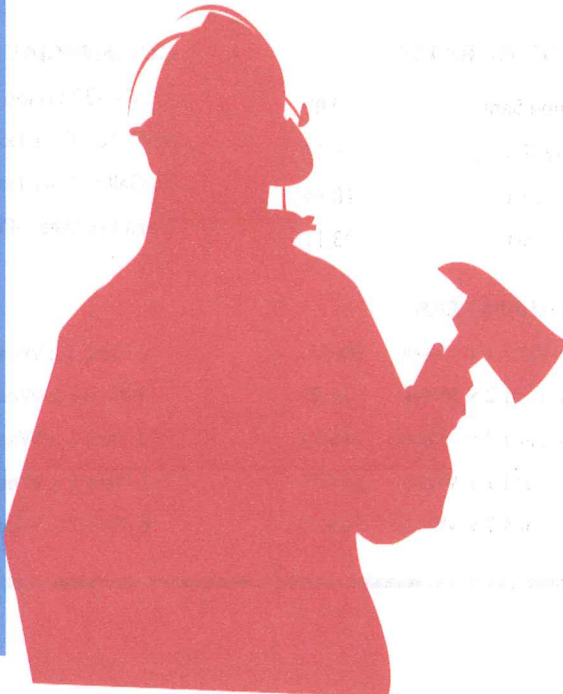
