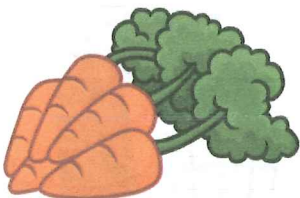

#### **Woodstove Replacement Program**

***This program intends to replace older non-certified woodstoves with EPA cleaner burning certified models to promote a healthier community.***

***They have funds to replace up to 30 uncertified stoves this year***

***Qualifications for participation in replacement program:***

- 1. The wood stove must be uncertified***
- 2. The woodstove must currently be used to heat the home***
- 3. Only wood or pellet stoves offered as replacement and installation through this program qualify. Other stoves and installers are not eligible under this program.***
- 4. The applicant must live in the home and be the owner***
- 5. Only free standing appliance will be replaced, fireplace inserts do not qualify.***
- 6. Must be within the Woodstove replacement boundary (Applicant must live in the Okanogan River Airshed emphasis area, Riverside to Malott (up to 1400 feet elevation))***
