Woodstove Replacement Program

This program intends to replace older non-certified woodstoves with EPA cleaner burning certified models to promote a healthier community.

They have funds to replace up to 30 uncertified stoves this

Qualifications for participation in replacement program:

1. The wood stove must be uncertified

2. The woodstove must currently be used to heat the home

3. Only wood or pellet stoves offered as replacement and installation through this program qualify. Other stoves and installers are not eligible under this program.

4. The applicant must live in the home and be the owner

5. Only free standing appliance will be replaced, fireplace

inserts do not qualify.

6. Must be within the Woodstove replacement boundary (Applicant must live in the Okanogan River Airshed emphasis area, Riverside to Malott (up to 1400 feet elevation)
