



Fireworks Use in the City of Omak

The Omak Fire Department would like to remind everyone about fireworks use within the City limits of Omak. Fireworks use within the Omak City limits off the Colville Indian Reservation will be restricted to **Safe n Sane fireworks only**. They can be purchased at Washington State licensed retail stands. There will be two licensed stands inside the City of Omak this year. They will be located at the Burger King parking lot and the Wal Mart parking lot. Legal fireworks include: novelty and smoke items, sparklers, spinners, multi aerials, helicopters, cones, fountains, wheels, roman candles and reloadable mortars 1 3/4" or smaller. Illegal fireworks include firecrackers, chasers, bottle rockets, missiles and rockets. Dates and times fireworks can legally be used are: June 28th - July 5th 12:00 noon - 12:00 midnight.

In a collaborative effort between the City of Omak and Colville Confederated Tribes Eastside Park has been designated as a fireworks discharge area for the Omak district of the Colville Indian Reservation. Safe n Sane fireworks are encouraged to be used for the safety of all. Fireworks can be discharged in the park from 12 noon to 12 midnight on July 4th.

Here are some fireworks safety tips:

- Have a bucket of water handy to place all spent fireworks into. This
 will ensure they are dead out before placing them into a garbage container.
- Never ignite fireworks in a container such as glass or metal.
- Light fireworks outdoors in a clear area away from houses and combustible materials such as bushes, grass and trees.
- Place fireworks that didn't go off into a bucket of water. Do not try to
 relight it.

Young children using fireworks should always have adult supervision.

The burn ban inside the City of Omak will start July 1st and will be in effect until October 1st. All open outdoor fires are prohibited during this time including fire pits. BBQ's are ok to use.
