
WHEREAS the Proclamation of Governor Inslee of a state of emergency on February 29, 2020, due to the Covid 19 pandemic has been rescinded by Governor Inslee on October 31, 2022, and Gov. Ensley has rescinded all Covid 19 emergency proclamations effective October 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS the Supreme Court of the state of Washington has issued a series of orders authorizing the Presiding Judges of Washington courts to adopt, modify, and/or suspend local court rules and orders and to take further actions regarding court operations as warranted for the safe and effective administration of justice due to the Covid 19 pandemic, the most recent of which is Supreme Court of Washington Order No. 25700-B-697;

WHEREAS the provisions of this court's Administrative Order No. 2020-001 are no longer necessary for the safe and effective administration of justice in this court due to the Covid 19 pandemic;

Therefore, Administrative Order No. 2020-001 made by this court on March 22, 2020, is hereby terminated.
