#### **Basic Function:**

Assists in the maintenance and Operations of the Omak Wastewater Treatment Plant. Including lab equipment and grounds, may also be required to work as utility crew person.

#### **Duties & Job Requirements:**

- 1. Plant Maintenance.
- 2. Perform laboratory tests and have basic computer skills.
- 3. Operate equipment such as UTV, loader, backhoe, tank truck, dump truck, lawn mower and forklift, vacuum truck.
- 4. Work with other utility personnel and preform physical work in all weather conditions.
- 5. Monitor and troubleshoot motors, gearboxes, pumps, valves, UV system and Bio filter press and report or correct any problems.
- 6. Respond to alarms and be able to operate specialized equipment to resolve problems.
- 7. Be able to evaluate and prioritize workload.

#### **Education:**

- 1. Must have high school education or equivalent.
- 2. A valid Washington State Driver's License.
- 3. Class B CDL endorsement within 12 months.
- 4. Be able to obtain OIT certification within 6 months and a group 1 certification within 18 months of start date.
- 5. Possession of a Group II Washington State Wastewater Certification issued by the State of Washington Department of Ecology within 3 years.

#### Responsibilities:

- 1. Assist in all aspects of operations and maintenance. Must be able to perform the duties in the absence of the Chief Operator
- 2. Subject to 24 hr. callout and respond to all emergencies.
- 3. Responsible for utilizing appropriate safety equipment with the intent to comply with pertinent safety regulations, standards, and guidelines.
- 4. May be subject to shift changes which could include evenings, nights, weekends, and holidays.
- 5. Maintain trouble shoot and repair plant equipment such as: pumps, bearings, mechanical seals, electric motors, UV system and Biofilter press.
- 6. Be familiar with VFD and PLC.
- 7. Good Record keeping skills.
- 8. Knowledge of DOE and EPA rules and regulations (173-308 WAC) (NPDES)
