RESOLUTION NO. 28-2013

AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT FOR REIMBURSABLE WORK BETWEEN OKANOGAN COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS AND THE CITY OF OMAK TO MOVE SEWER TREATMENT PLANT COMPOST BINS

WHEREAS, the City has had an Interagency Agreement with Okanogan County Public Works to move the compost bins at the Sewer Treatment Plant since 2006, at a cost of \$75.00 per hour; and

WHEREAS, the City continues to require these services and has received a revised Agreement listing three new provisos to the original contact: 1) contract will be in effect through December 31, 2015; 2) the cost will be \$80.00 per hour; 3) the County may, at its discretion, annually increase the rate by 3%, based upon its projected cost increases; and

WHEREAS, the public works department considers this to be a vital and necessary service to the operation of the composting process at the Sewer Treatment Plant Facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Omak, Washington do hereby approve the <u>Interagency Agreement for Reimbursable Work</u> to relocate compost bins at the Omak Sewage Treatment Plant, attached hereto as "Exhibit A", between the CITY OF OMAK, a municipal corporation, and OKANOGAN COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, a County government, with an effective date of January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2015. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the same for and on behalf of the City, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest her signature.
