WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Transportation will reimburse the City of Omak for the cost associated with the relocation of this utility, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Omak that the <u>Temporary Service Agreement</u> for utility relocation, between the City of Omak and Washington State Department of Transportation, "SBT 1306", a copy of which is attached hereto as "Exhibit A", is hereby approved, and the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute and attest the agreement on behalf of the City.

Temporary Service Agreement SBT 1306 SR 215, Omak Area Paving, XL 3854 City of Omak

This Temporary Service Agreement is between the City of Omak and WSDOT. Under WSDOT's proposed contract titled, "SR 215, Omak Area Paving", WSDOT will be updating city sidewalks to current ADA requirements. This ADA work will require a water hydrant and valve to be relocated. This Temporary Service Agreement was set up to cover the City's costs to perform the relocation of this water hydrant and valve.

The water hydrant and valve to be relocated is located in the SE quadrant of SR 215 and 3rd Ave, See Exhibit B, page 1. The City has provided WSDOT with an estimate of costs of \$2,160 to relocate the water hydrant and valve, see Exhibit A, page 1. WSDOT agrees to reimburse the City for their actual direct and indirect costs, therefore this Temporary Service Agreement is set up as an Actual Cost Agreement, not to exceed \$2,700.00, and will be paid under the contract as a below the line item.

The City agrees to submit an actual cost, itemized invoice to WSDOT. Upon receipt of this invoice, WSDOT agrees to reimburse the city within 30 days.




