## INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN WASHINGTON DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE AND CITY OF OMAK

This Agreement, pursuant to RCW 39.34, is made and entered into by the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) and the City of Omak (Omak), together referred to as the Parties.

By this Agreement, WDFW and Cmak clarify interests, ownership, and responsibilities relating to sewer line connecting a WDFW hatchery in Omak to the Omak main sewer line.

## **TERMS**

- 1. <u>WDFW Sewer Pipeline Franchise</u>. The Parties agree to jointly file, before the Board of County Commissioners of Okanogan County, an application to terminate Franchise No. 76-4, dated November 8, 1976; which franchise was requested by WDFW, and issued by the Okanogan County for the construction of the sewer along or under Emery Street (OCR 2587) and Omak Fish Hatchery Road (OCR 2595) hereinafter called the "Fish Hatchery Sewer Line" or "FHSL".
- 2. <u>City of Omak</u>. Upon the Board of County Commissioners of Okanogan County terminating any and all WDFW interest in Franchise No. 76-4, WDFW shall provide notice of same to Omak. Omak shall then provide WDFW certification that there are no other recorded real property interests against WDFW relating to the construction, operation and or maintenance of the Fish Hatchery Sewer Line; and Omak shall provide a written statement that there are no outstanding

- claims by the City of Omak against WDFW related to the FHSL. Lastly, Omak shall provide written notice to WDFW of any other known claims, interests, liens, damages or the like related to the Fish Hatchery Sewer Line made by any person.
- 3. Ownership Interest in Fish Hatchery Sewer Line. Upon receipt of the certifications and notices above, and in consideration of the maintenance Omak performed since construction of the FHSL; in consideration of Omak's assumption of full responsibility for ownership, operation, and maintenance of the FHSL; and in consideration of Omak's assistance in negotiating and undertaking the terms of this Agreement, WDFW shall transfer, by written letter acknowledgment, any and all remaining interest in the Fish Hatchery Sewer Line to the City of Omak. The Parties agree that for purposes of this Agreement the Fish Hatchery Sewer Line ends at the entrance to the Omak Fish Hatchery property. WDFW owns the sewer line on the Fish Hatchery Property.
- 4. Release of All Liabilities. Upon transfer of ownership interest in the Fish Hatchery Sewer Line, Omak agrees to release the WDFW from all outstanding claims, liabilities and obligations arising under Franchise No. 76-4.
- 5. <u>Independent Capacity</u>. The employees or agents of each party who are engaged in the performance of this agreement shall continue to be employees or agents of that party and shall not be considered for any purpose to be employees or agents of the other party.

- 6. Agreement Alterations and Amendments. This Agreement may be amended by mutual agreement of the parties. Such amendments shall not be binding unless they are in writing and signed by personnel authorized to bind each of the parties.
- Assignment. The work to be provided under this Agreement, and any claim arising thereunder, is not assignable or delegable by either party in whole or in part, without the express prior written consent of the other party, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld.
- 8. <u>All Writings Contained Herein</u>. This Agreement contains all the terms and conditions agreed upon by the parties. No other understanding, oral or otherwise, regarding the subject matter of this Agreement shall be deemed to exist or to bind any of the parties hereto.
