RESOLUTION No. 57-2014

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OMAK, WASHINGTON, APPROVING TWO EMERGENCY LAND USE AGREEMENTS WITH THE WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR USE OF PORTIONS OF EASTSIDE PARK AND OMAK AIRPORT FOR CARLTON COMPLEX WILDFIRE DEFENSE

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has requested two Emergency Land Use Agreements with the City for the use of specific portions of Eastside Park to set up an Incident Command Base Camp, and an area of Omak Municipal Airport for incident air operations in support of the Carlton Complex wildfire; and

WHEREAS, both arrangements were made with the DNR on July 18th because the sudden eruption in size of the fire necessitated immediate action to establish a base camp and air support, and there was not enough time to establish Emergency Land Use Agreements on paper before the next regularly scheduled Council meeting; and

WHEREAS, the term for use of the Airport is specified as July 18, 2014 through August 18, 2014, unless otherwise modified by the parties; and

WHEREAS, the term for use of Eastside Park is specified as July 18, 2014 through August 1, 2014, unless otherwise modified by the parties; and

WHEREAS, both Agreements specify the same compensation rate; daily, weekly or monthly; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Omak, Washington, hereby approves and ratifies the Omak Municipal Airport Air Base Operations Emergency Land Use Rental Agreement, attached as "Exhibit A", and the Omak Eastside Park Incident Command Base Camp Emergency Land Use Rental Agreement, attached as "Exhibit B", between the City of Omak, and the State of Washington Department of Natural Resources, for use of portions of Omak East Side Park and an area at the Omak Municipal Airport to combat the Carlton Complex wildfire.
